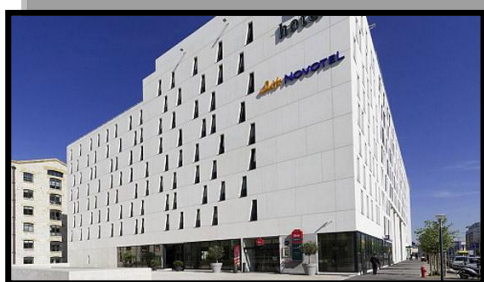


Ibis (3*)

Marseille EuroMéditerranée Ibis Hotel is in the very heart of the new Euro-Mediterranean district and close to the Docks. Only 10-15 minutes' walk to the city centre, the main touristic sites are easily served by tram and metro: *Vieux Port, Panier district, Canebière...* It is directly connected to Saint Charles train station by metro. The Hotel offers 192 air-conditioned and WiFi-connected rooms with 5 wheelchair access' rooms and Café Pasta Pizza restaurant with terrace.

Distance from the conference venue: 20 minutes walking or 10 minutes by metro (1.2km).



Suite Novotel (4*)

The **Suite Novotel** is also in the very heart of the new Euro-Mediterranean district and surrounded by the maritime front and the Docks. It is directly connected to Saint Charles train station by metro too. This hotel recently created a brand new Suite which combines design, innovation and space. You can enjoy a recreated home in your 30m² Suite (323 sq. ft.) with many services of the Suite Box: Internet, music and movies on demand and national telephone calls all free and unlimited.

Distance from the conference venue: 20 minutes walking or 10 minutes by metro (1.2km).



HOW TO REACH YOUR HOTEL:

From Saint Charles Rail Station to Ibis or Suite Novotel

Follow the signs for the Metro terminal. Take line 2, red with direction to “Bougainville”, step off at “Joliette”. The hotels are just 5 minutes walking from this metro station. If you don’t want to walk, you may take the tramway from the tramway station “Joliette” (near the metro station) to “Méditerranée- Gantès” (in front of the hotels).
